Showing the site plan indicating how motorcaravans should park is an easy way of ensuring that space is occupied according to the way the Aire has been designed. It also can avoid any confusion as to how many vans are allowed to park.

### Site Rules

What you expect of your guests. What the fees are and how they will be collected. If advance booking is required.

### Traffic Regulation Order

If applicable A4 document outlining the details of the Traffic Regulation Order or details how to find the information i.e. on the sites website.

### Public Liability Insurance.

If applicable A4 copy of your Public Liability Insurance. or details how to find the information i.e. on the sites website.

### CAMpRA Accreditation

The CAMpRA Accreditation Certificate.

### Local Attractions/Facilities List

Include such things as Shops, Pubs, tourist attractions

### Local Services

Include such things as nearest Doctors, Petrol Station, LPG Station, Motorhome/Caravan Dealers, Contact details for Taxi services,

Out of hours contacts for emergencies

What 3 words grid references for key locations can be used – its an easy to use app available and is great for use when postcodes don't work or grid references get complicated.
